## Our Youth

Smoking prevalence in California has steadily declined from 2012 to 2016. Smoking rates among youth has declined significantly, however they remain targets for the tobacco industry. If smoking continues at the current rate among youth in California, more individuals younger than 18 will suffer from a smoking-related illness.
